- 5. In the School Children's Section, Class Number **must be** clearly stated on the outside on the competition label, name and school or nursery on the inside or reverse of the exhibit.
- 6. The decision of the Judge is final.
- 7 <u>A competition label must be attached to each exhibit</u> showing the Section and Class Number as indicated on the schedule.
- 8. Entries are limited to one exhibit in each class except for classes 49, 50, 51. They are allowed three entries per class, also exhibits must be new and unused.
- 9. There will be no entry fee for any competition.
- 10. All exhibits to be the Competitor's own unaided work.
- 11. All handwork must be completed within 12 months of the show.
- 12. No knitted article to be laundered before exhibition.
- 13. No exhibits may be removed before 4.00p.m. Any exhibits remaining after 4.45p.m. will be disposed of.
- 14. The Handicraft Committee of the Lochaber Agricultural Show will **not be responsible for lost or damaged exhibits.**
- 15. The presentation of trophies will be held at 3.30p.m. Within the Handicraft Tent.

Tea Loaf

170g Sultans 170g Raisins 1 Orange Zested

300ml Hot Strong Tea 2 Med Eggs Beaten 250g SR Flour 200g Light Soft Brown Sugar Butter for Greasing

Mix fruits in a bowl, pour over hot tea, leave overnight or 6 hours minimum.

Preheat oven at 180c/160c fan/Gas 4. Grease & line 900g loaf tin.

Add eggs, flour and sugar to fruit and tea mixture, combining well. Pour into prepared loaf tin, bake for 1hour 30 mins in centre of oven, or until firm to the touch. Leave to cool slightly before removing from tin.
